TO RESERVE A SPACE

A deposit of \$200.00 per person is required to reserve a seat. Full payment is due February 1, 2012.

ACCOMMODATIONS

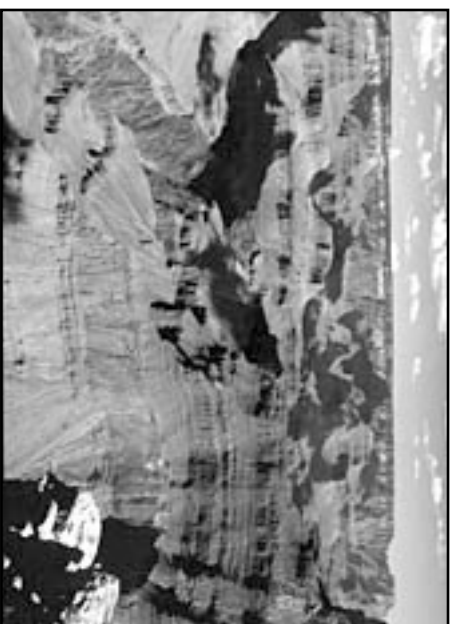

Day 1

Sunday, April 15

Home—Topeka, Kansas

Day 2

Monday, April 16

Topeka—Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

By early afternoon we arrive in Oklahoma City, where we visit the **NATIONAL COWBOY HALL OF FAME**. The complex commemorates men and women who pioneered the West, including Gene Autry, Roy Rogers and Dale Evans of western television.

Day 3

Tuesday, April 17

Oklahoma City - Albuquerque, New Mexico

Heading west we travel through the state of Oklahoma and on to "The Lone Star State" of Texas. Passing through Amarillo, cattle ranches, along with cotton and wheat fields dot the countryside. Arriving in **Albuquerque** our 3 night stay is at the Holiday Inn & Suites Hotel. Welcome to **New Mexico**, "The Land of Enchantment".

Day 4

Wednesday, April 18

Albuquerque, New Mexico

The best place to learn the history and culture of Albuquerque and the State of New Mexico is at **Old Town**. Founded in 1706, the quaint shops with a mix of victorian and adobe style buildings still bear traces of the period. Next we visit the **Indian Pueblo Cultural Center** and enjoy craft demonstrations, Indian dances and traditional Pueblo food. This after-



noon we board the **Scandia Peak Tramway**, one of the longest aerial trams in the world, 2.7 miles offering panoramic views of the **Rio Grande Valley** at a height of 10,678 feet. This evening we enjoy some fun gaming at the Scandia Casino with dinner included.

Day 5

Thursday, April 19

Albuquerque, New Mexico

Today we travel a short distance to the capital city of **Santa Fe**. Here we retrace the "**Old Santa Fe Trail**" and walk the streets where "**Billy the Kid**" ruled. Known for its world-famous chapels and missions, we visit the **Chapel of Guadalupe** and **Mission of San Miguel**. The mission is one of the country's oldest churches, dating back to 1610. Next we visit **Loretto Chapel** which contains a spiral staircase with two 360-degree turns and no apparent nails or support beams. It is known today as the Miraculous Staircase. Before returning to our hotel in Albuquerque, we visit the **Palace of Governors**, built in 1609, known as the oldest public building in the United States serving as the seat of government.

Day 6

Friday, April 20

Albuquerque-Flagstaff, Arizona

Today we travel west along the **Zuni Mountains** and the **Chibola National Forest**, making a stop at Gallup, a trading center for the Navajo. From here we pass **Painted Cliffs**, the **Petrified Forest National Park** and **Walnut Canyon** and then on to Flagstaff for a 2 night stay at the Holiday Inn.

Day 7

Saturday, April 21

Flagstaff, Arizona

Get ready as we travel the winding course of **Oak Creek Canyon**. The densely wooded canyon wall slowly changes from rich hues of gray-pink limestone into red sandstone that provides fantastic photographic views. Next we come to the Spanish settle-

ment of **Sedona**. Nestled along **Oak Creek**, Sedona is truly a vacation paradise. Following lunch and shopping we visit the beautiful **Chapel of the Holy Cross**, built high in the towering pinnacles of **Red Rock Canyon**.

Day 8

Sunday, April 22

Flagstaff—Las Vegas, Nevada

The **Grand Canyon** is today's highlight. One of the "Seven Wonders of the World", the Canyon, 10 million years in the making, is spectacular. Upon arrival take a leisurely stroll along the rim of the Canyon, enjoy lunch and shop the many craft stores. Next we come to **Hoover Dam**, built in 1936, it is the highest concrete dam ever constructed. Then, it's all aboard for the western gambling capital of the nation, **Las Vegas**. We enjoy our 2 night stay in downtown Las Vegas on Fremont Street. (*Good Luck*)

Las Vegas, Nevada

Today we enjoy the flair of Las Vegas. Fabulous casinos, the famous Strip, music shows, shopping galore and great tasting buffets.
